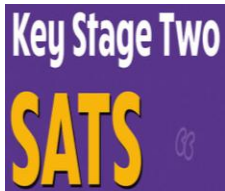

**SATs week**

I hope all Y6 families are aware that next week is SATs week for children in Y6. Children will be taking national assessments in Maths, Reading, Spelling Punctuation and Grammar. Several staff are supporting with this, and we will do our best to reassure and encourage children. Please can I ask families to ensure that children have early nights over the weekend and arrive on time ready to go on Monday morning. We are offering breakfast sessions with children as it does help if they are not hungry! Encourage children to try their best and think about everything that has been done to prepare them.

**Tiktok / social media access**

Lately, we have seen an increase with a few children involved with 'roasting' each other, and unfortunately this is involving some children with making derogatory comments, insulting each other and name calling. Sometimes children do not appreciate the seriousness of this behaviour and impact on others, almost thinking it is just 'banter' and there is no harm. This is partly influenced by tiktok and social media platforms which children are accessing and shouldn't be. We do mention quite frequently that there are age restrictions on access and these sites need to be monitored and checked at home. Although it isn't easy, please do speak with your child about what they are accessing and also the consequences of unacceptable comments as it does cause considerable upset.
