### Allergies

A new law is to be implemented in September '26 called Benedict's Law. Sadly, this law came about following the death of a child in school due to an allergic reaction. The law will require schools to have a clear allergy policy, named allergy lead, staff training and spare adrenaline pens. While we already have much of this in place, it will further tighten procedures.



Sometimes, the effect of an allergic reaction can be underestimated – although many reactions can be relatively mild, sometimes they can be life threatening and fatal. We have been asking for a long time that food is not brought into school to be shared e.g. no sweets / chocolates to be brought in for birthdays, if there is a party children have their own individual food plate (with no nut products), and where we may occasionally have an event where food is shared we ask Chartwells to provide who follow government guidelines for food preparation.

We do sometimes have families bring foods at the end of the day to be shared, and am afraid that we do ask that this isn't offered. If you wish to do so outside of school, we would advise that you give to a parent and not directly to a child (who may not be able to manage their allergies independently yet). I know sometimes families want to provide something for a birthday and again would suggest alternatives to food are considered e.g. stickers, small stationary items etc.

It is important that as a whole school community we do what we can to ensure that no-one experiences an allergic reaction due to our actions. Thank you.
