KS2 SATs results

I know you were notified that the KS2 SATs results were delayed this year, and we only got results in yesterday. Figures may vary by a few percent as papers are still being checked, but we believe Y6 have achieved:



Reading 72% (validated)

Maths 81% (validated)

Writing 71% (validated)

SPAG 75% (validated)

Combined 55% (unvalidated - will possibly increase by a few percent)

These are fantastic results (along with our other great results in EYFS, phonics, Y4 multiplication check etc) and a reflection of the work of all the staff with these children throughout their primary years, but of course, especially the Y6 team. A great way to end the year.



Student of the year awards

I would like to thank First Class Learning who have donated the trophies for the 'Student of the Year' awards. It is quite daunting for staff to have to select just one pupil for this award as we do know all of the children try hard. Staff consider whether children have demonstrated something exceptional and award on this basis. The list of students of the year for classes is attached to this newsletter.
